 - query capabilities
 - update support (and data consistency)
- Validation in two different P2P contexts: clusters of PC and the Internet

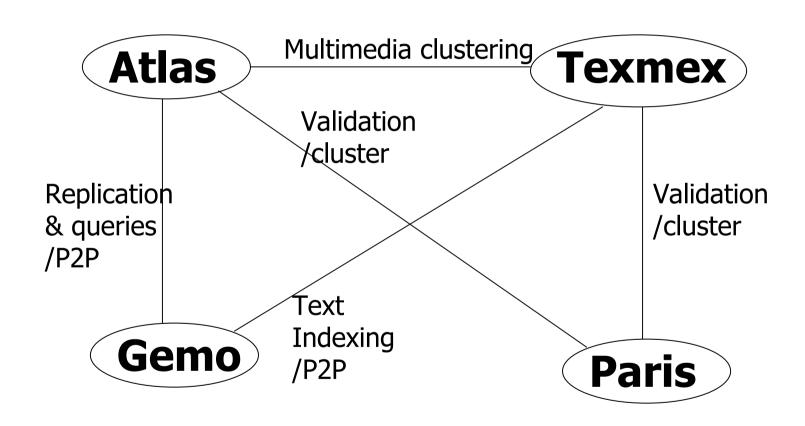


Research themes

- Preventive DB replication software for database clusters

- Atlas P2P Architecture (APPA)

- Multimedia data clustering
